A Bill to amend The Alberta Livestock and Livestock
Products Act

HON. MR. HALMRAST

Explanatory Note

Section 17 presently reads:

"17. A person contravening a provision of this Act or of a regulation is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction where no other penalty is prescribed to a fine of not more than one thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months."

Unless it is expressly otherwise provided summary conviction proceedings can only be commenced within six months of the commission of the alleged offence. The amendment extends the time under section 17 to two years.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. Section 17 of *The Alberta Livestock and Livestock
Products Act*, being chapter 181 of the Revised Statutes
is amended

- (a) by renumbering the present section 17 as subsection
(1),
- (b) by adding immediately after the renumbered sub-
section (1) the following subsection:
 - (2) A prosecution under this section may be
commenced within two years of the commission of
the alleged offence but not afterward.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is
assented to.
