Explanatory Note

2. Section 6 reads as follows:

"6. (1) The Chief Judge of the District Court of the District of Northern Alberta shall reside in the City of Edmonton and the Chief Judge of the District Court of the District of Southern Alberta shall reside in the City of Calgary.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Chief Judge may reside in any other city in the district for which he is appointed if he obtains the approval in writing of the Attorney General.".

3. Section 10 presently reads:

- "10. Each district court judge shall reside
- (a) within the district of which his commission designates him as as a judge, and
- (b) at such place as the Attorney General in writing approves.".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The District Courts Act, being chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6 is repealed.

3. Section 10 is amended by striking out clause (b) and by substituting the following:

(b) at such place as the Chief Judge of the district of which his commission designates him as judge, in writing approves.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
