A Bill to Change Certain Statutory References to the Provincial Secretary

Explanatory Note

General. The Acts referred to in this Bill designate the Provincial Secretary with regard to the administration of these Acts. It is desired to change these references to the member of the Executive Council who may be charged with the administration thereof so that the Public Service provision authorizing the Lieutenant Governor in Council to change the administration could apply without conflict with express provisions of these Acts.

Section 28, subsection (1), clause (a) presently reads:
"28. (1) A discipline committee is hereby constituted which shall consist of

(a) the Deputy Provincial Secretary, who shall be chairman,"

2. Section 27 presently reads:

"27. The registrar when called upon to do so shall provide the Provincial Secretary with a copy of the annual roll."

3. (b) Section 31, subsection (2) presently reads:

"(2) The registrar

- (a) on the first day of each month shall provide the Provincial Secretary with a list of all additions, deletions and changes of address made in the register during the preceding month, and
 (b) when called upon to do so shall provide the Provincial Secretary
- (b) when called upon to do so shall provide the Provincial Secretary with a roll of all members of the College."
- (c) Section 77 presently reads:

"77. The registrar, whenever required by the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall transmit to the Provincial Secretary a certified return under the seal of the council, setting out all such information and particulars relating to the College as may from time to time be required."

4. Section 25, subsection (1), clause (a) presently reads:
"25. (1) A discipline committee is hereby constituted, which shall consist of

(a) the Deputy Provincial Secretary, who shall be chairman,".

5. Section 3, clause (f) presently reads:

"3. In this Act,

(f) "Minister" means the Provincial Secretary."

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 28 of *The Chiropractic Act*, being chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out the words "Provincial Secretary" where they occur in clause (a) of subsection (1) and by substituting the word "Minister".

2. Section 27 of *The Dental Association Act*, being chapter 82 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out the words "Provincial Secretary" and by substituting the words "member of the Executive Council charged with the administration of this Act".

3. The Medical Profession Act, being chapter 198 of the Revised Statutes, is amended

- (a) as to section 2 by adding immediately after clause
 - (f) the following:
 - (ff) "Minister" means that member of the Executive Council charged with the administration of this Act;
- (b) as to section 31, subsection (2) by striking out the words "Provincial Secretary" where they occur in clauses (a) and (b) and by substituting the word "Minister",
- (c) as to section 77 by striking out the words "Provincial Secretary" and by substituting the word "Minister".

4. Section 25 of *The Naturopathy Act*, being chapter 221 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out the words "Provincial Secretary" where they occur in clause (a) of subsection (1) and by substituting the word "Minister".

5. Section 3 of *The Optometry Act*, being chapter 229 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out clause (f) and by substituting the following:

(f) "Minister" means that member of the Executive Council charged with the administration of this Act.

6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
