A Bill to amend The Apprenticeship Act

HON. MR. REIERSON

Explanatory Note

Section 14 presently reads:

"14. No person who is eligible under this Act to be an apprentice in any designated trade and who has not completed the period of apprenticeship prescribed for him shall be employed in that trade for more than three months unless

- (a) he is authorized by the Board to be so employed, or**
- (b) he enters into a contract of apprenticeship in accordance with this Act and the regulations.**

An Act to amend The Apprenticeship Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Apprenticeship Act*, being chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words "for more than three months" where they occur in section 14 thereof.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
