#### **Explanatory Note**

#### Section 14 presently reads:

"14. No person who is eligible under this Act to be an apprentice in any designated trade and who has not completed the period of apprenticeship prescribed for him shall be employed in that trade for more than three months unless

- (a) he is authorized by the Board to be so employed, or(b) he enters into a contract of apprenticeship in accordance with this Act and the regulations.

- 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
