Explanatory Note

General. This Bill will authorize the Government to enter into agreements with the Government of Canada in any plans developed by that Government between now and the next session of the Alberta Legislature.

An Act to Authorize the Government of Alberta to Enter into Arrangements with the Government of Canada concerning Land Use and Conservation, Farm Credit and Crop Insurance or any of these Matters Pending Particular Provincial Legislation in Respect thereof.

(Assented to , 1959)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Federal-Provincial Farm Assistance Act".

2. For the purpose of obtaining for Alberta the benefits of any arrangements or proposals of the Government of Canada relating to any or all of the following matters, that is to say:

- (a) farm or other land use and conservation, including irrigation and water development;
- (b) farm credit;
- (c) crop insurance;

the Minister of Agriculture is hereby empowered to enter into agreements with the appropriate Ministers of the Government of Canada to that purpose and may obligate the Province to any extent considered necessary to obtain any such benefit or to effect any such arrangements or proposals in Alberta.

3. An agreement made pursuant to section 2 shall be effective upon the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council thereto and shall be tabled in the Assembly within fifteen days after the commencement of the session of the Legislature next ensuing after the agreement is entered into.

4. Where any such agreement requires the modification or amendment of any existing legislation in force in Alberta, the agreement shall be made subject to validation at the next ensuing session of the Legislature.

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
