# BILL

No. 105 of 1959

An Act for Granting to Her Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respectively the Thirty-first Day of March, 1958, the Thirty-first Day of March, 1959, and the Thirty-first Day of March, 1960

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1959)

*Most Gracious Sovereign:*

**W**HEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, John J. Bowlen, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively, the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-eight; the Thirty-first day of March, one Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-nine, and the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Appropriation Act, 1959*".

**2.** From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, One Hundred and Fifty-one Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty-two Dollars and Forty-three cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-seven, to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-eight, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act.

**3.** From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, Fourteen Million, Four Hundred and Thirty Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty-two Dollars and Five Cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-eight to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-nine, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "B" to this Act.

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding Three Hundred and Four Million, Six Hundred and Seventy-six Thousand, Three Hundred and Fifty-eight Dollars, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-nine, to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in Schedule "C" to this Act.

5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
