An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Land Which is the Property of the Canadian Union College, College Heights, Alberta, from Assessment and Taxation

WHEREAS the Canadian Union College of College Preamble Heights. Alberta, has presented a petition, praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain land, belonging to the Canadian Union College from assessment and taxation, other than that relating to local improvements, and mines and minerals, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner;

THEREFORE Her Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The property located at College Heights in the Pro-Exemption vince of Alberta, and described as follows, namely: All that taxation portion of the West Half of Section Thirty-one (31), in Township Forty (40), Range Twenty-six (26), West of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, which is bounded as follows: on the North by a line drawn parallel to the production Westerly of the North Limit of the Unnamed Avenue shown on Subdivision Plan 4046 B.N. and perpendicularly distant Eight Hundred and Fifty-eight (858) feet Southerly therefrom; on the South-East and East by the Westerly limit of the surveyed Road shown on Road Plan 2533 K.S., on the South by the North boundary of the land subdivided by Plan 151 Z (all the above mentioned Plans being of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District); on the West by the West boundary of the South-West Quarter of said Section Thirty-one (31), and on the North-West by the South-Easterly bank of Barnett Lake (Lake No. 1) containing in the North-West Quarter of said Section Thirtyone (31) Seventeen (17) acres more or less, and in the South-West Quarter of said Section Thirty-one (31), Thirty-five (35) acres more or less, a total area of fifty-two (52) acres, more or less, shall be exempt from assessment and taxation, other than taxes relating to local improvements and mines and minerals, so long as it shall remain registered in the name of the Canadian Union College, and owned by it, and used by it for or in connection with educational purposes, whether of a theological nature, or otherwise.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is Coming into force assented to.
