A Bill to amend The Arbitration Act

HON. MR. MANNING

Explanatory Note

I. The fees an arbitrator under The Arbitration Act may demand are increased. Schedule B presently reads:

"SCHEDULE B
(Sections 18, 19, 20 and 24)

	Non-professional arbitrators	Professional arbitrators
When the arbitrator's residence is in the Province, for each full day and for each portion of a day not less than one-half necessarily absent from such residence in going to, staying at and returning from the place where the arbitration is held	\$20.00	\$40.00
When the arbitrator's residence is out of the Province, for each full day and for each portion of a day not less than one-half necessarily spent in travelling within the Province to and from the place where the arbitration is held, and for each day spent at such place during the arbitration	\$20.00	\$40.00
For each portion of a day less than one-half spent as mentioned above	\$10.00	\$20.00".

An Act to amend The Arbitration Act

(Assented to _____, 1960)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Arbitration Act*, being chapter 15 of the Revised Statutes, is amended as to Schedule B

- (a) by striking out the figure "\$20.00" wherever it occurs and by substituting the figure "\$30.00",
- (b) by striking out the figure "\$40.00" wherever it occurs and by substituting the figure "\$60.00",
- (c) by striking out the figure "\$10.00" and by substituting the figure "\$15.00".

2. (1) This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

(2) Section 1 applies only in respect of fees for travelling, attendance and services incurred on or after the date this Act comes into force.
