A Bill to amend The Teachers' Retirement Fund Act

Explanatory Note

2. Because of The Lloydminster Municipal Amalgamation Act, 1930 (1930, chap. 54), the Lloydminster Public School is specifically referred to in this Act (as in some other Acts) as The School Act (Alberta) need not necessarily apply to that municipal area. Recently the Roman Catholic Separate School District was established therein using the Saskatchewan School Act, and reference is similarly made thereto.

3. When the Act was enacted by 1939, chap. 21, section 7 thereof provided for terms of office in terms similar to the proposed new section 6, the years mentioned being 1941 and 1943, respectively. By an error in the revision of 1955, several words were changed in the printing, so that the expiration dates appeared to have been altered. The new section will re-enact the original intent, changing only the reference to the years.

4. This amendment repeals Statutes of Alberta, 1956, chapter 52, section 10, which removed the words here being inserted. A teacher will thereby not be required to contribute to the Teachers' Retirement Fund for more than 35 years. Section 10 presently reads:

"10. Every teacher shall contribute to the Fund an amount equal to such per cent, not being less than four per cent nor more than seven per cent, of his salary as a teacher, as the Board of Administrators by by-law may determine."

5. See note to clause 2. Subsection (1) of section 11 presently reads:

"11. (1) The board of trustees of each school district and school division in the Province of Alberta and of the Lloydminster Public School District shall retain from the salary of each teacher the percentage that he is required to contribute to the Fund in accordance with section 10."

6. See note to clause 2. Section 12(1)(a)(ii) presently reads:

"12. (1) The Department of Education shall

(a) retain semi-annually at the end of each school term

.....
(ii) from the grants payable to the Lloydminster Public School District,

an amount equal to the amount required to be retained by the board of trustees from the salaries of all teachers of each school district and school division during each term, and"

7. New section 14a permits a contributor to the Teachers' Retirement Fund employed by the University to elect to remain a contributor to the Fund; in which case, the University also makes a contribution to the Fund on his behalf.

An Act to amend The Teachers' Retirement Fund Act

(Assented to _____, 1960)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Teachers' Retirement Fund Act*, being chapter 330 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2, clause (d), subclause (i) is amended by adding immediately after the word "District" the words "or the Lloydminster Roman Catholic Separate School District".

3. Section 6 is struck out and the following is substituted:

6. The two other members of the Board of Administrators shall be teachers and shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, one of whom shall serve until the thirtieth day of June, 1961, while the other shall serve until the thirtieth day of June, 1963, and their successors from time to time appointed shall serve for a term of four years each from the dates at which their respective appointments take effect.

4. Section 10 is amended by adding after the word "shall" the words ", until he has made contributions to the Fund for a total period not exceeding thirty-five years,".

5. Section 11, subsection (1) is amended by adding immediately after the word "District" the words "and the Lloydminster Roman Catholic Separate School District".

6. Section 12, subsection (1), clause (a), subclause (ii) is amended by adding immediately after the word "District" the words "and the Lloydminster Roman Catholic Separate School District".

7. The following section is added immediately after section 14:

14a. (1) In this section "university teacher" means a teacher employed by the Governors of the University of Alberta as a full-time member of the academic staff of the University.

8. Commencement. Certain provisions are to have retroactive effect as stated.

(2) Where a teacher who is contributing to the Fund becomes a university teacher, the teacher may elect to continue contributions to the Fund and upon any such election the Governors of the University of Alberta shall retain from the salary of the teacher the amount required to be retained by a board of trustees under section 11, and shall pay over the moneys retained to the Board of Administrators at such times and in such manner as the Board of Administrators may direct.

(3) At the same time and in the same manner, the Governors of the University of Alberta shall pay to the Board of Administrators an amount equal to the contributions of the university teacher, for deposit in the revenue account established under section 17.

8. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force sections 2, 5 and 6 have effect on and after the first day of June, 1959, and section 7 has effect on and after the first day of September, 1959.
