Explanatory Note

- 2. Section 43(1)(a) establishes the hours during which the office of the Clerk of the Court must be open to the public for business. At present the office may be closed at one o'clock in the afternoon during vacation, that is, the times when the Courts are not sitting full time. This amendment will require the Clerk to keep his office open to the public from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. all year around. Section 43(1)(a) presently reads:
 - "43. (1) There shall be a Clerk of the Court who shall
 - (a) attend at his office to keep the office open
 - (i) between the hours of ten in the forenoon and four-thirty in the afternoon on all days except Saturdays and holidays when the office shall be closed, and
 - (ii) between the hours of ten in the forenoon and one in the afternoon on all days during vacation except Saturdays and holidays when the office shall be closed,".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Judicature Act, being chapter 164 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 43, subsection (1) is amended as to clause (a) by striking out subclause (ii).
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
