A Bill to amend The Mineral Titles Redemption Act

### **Explanatory Note**

- 2. The purpose of this amendment is to extend for one year the time for making application to redeem certain mineral titles now possessed by the Crown in right of Alberta by forfeiture or transfer under The Mineral Taxation Acts. Section 4, subsection (1) presently reads:
  - "4. (1) A person whose minerals have heretofore vested in Her Majesty under The Mineral Taxation Act, 1945, or The Mineral Taxation Act, 1947, or a person on his behalf may, on or before the thirty-first day of March, 1960, apply to the Superintendent to recover title to the minerals."

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Mineral Titles Redemption Act, being chapter 44 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1958, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 4, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the figures "1960" and by substituting the figures "1961".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
