Animals Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 48(1)(c) is amended to make it identical to the equivalent provisions in The Domestic Animals (Municipalities) Act and to make it applicable to land other than cultivated land. Section 48 (1) (c) presently reads:

"48. (1) Any person who,

.....

(c) wilfully causes any animal to trespass on cultivated land, any stack of hay, feed or grain, is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months."

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Improvement Districts Stray Animals Act*, being
chapter 151 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 48, subsection (1) is amended by striking out
clause (c) and by substituting the following:

(c) for the purpose of permitting an animal to tres-
pass on another person's land, leaves open a gate
or lets down a bar or makes a gap in a fence sur-
rounding or protecting that land, or wilfully causes
an animal to trespass thereon,

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
