# **BILL 74**

A Bill to amend The Maintenance Order Act

#### **Explanatory Note**

This Bill will permit a parent or guardian or next friend of a child who is entitled to maintenance under this Act to bring the application, where, at present, in the case of a child only the Superintendent of Child Welfare is so expressly authorized. Section 5(1) as relevant presently reads:

"5. (1) Where a person liable under section 3 or section 4 of this Act to maintain any other person refuses or neglects to do so,

(f) the Superintendent of Child Welfare if the person entitled to maintenance is a child,
may apply summarily to a judge of the district court having jurisdiction in the judicial district in which the person entitled or the person liable resides for a maintenance order against the person liable.".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- **1.** The Maintenance Order Act, being chapter 188 of the Revised Statutes, is amended as to subsection (1) of section 5 by striking out clause (f) and by substituting the following:
  - (f) if the person entitled to maintenance is a child, a parent or guardian of the child, or the Superintendent of Child Welfare, or the child by its next friend,
- 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
