A Bill to amend The Students Assistance Act, 1959

HON. MR. AALBORG

Explanatory Note

2. By this amendment the Act brings within its benefits students who are registered, for University recognized credit courses, at a private college affiliated with the University of Alberta. Section 8(1) as relevant presently reads:

"8. (1) A person is eligible to receive a loan, grant, bursary, prize or scholarship under this Act who is a bona fide resident of the Province and who is registered in a course of studies approved by the Board,

.....

(b) at a junior college established under The Public Junior Colleges Act,".

3. The authority to prescribe terms and conditions by regulation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council will be broadened. (cf. section 5 of Act). Section 12 as relevant reads:

"12. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations for the purpose of carrying out the intent and objects of this Act, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing may make regulations prescribing

.....

(c) the terms and conditions under which loans are to be made,".

An Act to amend The Students Assistance Act, 1959

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Students Assistance Act*, being chapter 83 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1959, is hereby amended.

2. Section 8 is amended as to subsection (1) by adding immediately at the end of clause (b) the words "or at a college in affiliation with the University of Alberta for which, in the latter case, University credit may be obtained at the University of Alberta,".

3. Section 12 is amended by striking out clause (c) and by substituting the following:

(c) the terms and conditions under which any assistance is awarded,

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
