A Bill to amend The Provincial Secretary's Act

### **Explanatory Note**

- 1. These amendments result from the transfer to the Provincial Secretary of functions previously carried out by the Minister of Economic Affairs until the repeal of the Department of Economic Affairs Act at the last Session. It is intended that some of these functions be continued.
  - (9.) Section 9 re-enacts section 5(2) of the repealed Act.
- (10.) This re-enacts the substance of section 7 of the repealed The Department of Economic Affairs Act.

(11.) New. This new section gives express statutory authority for making grants for recreational facilities in communities in the Province.

An Act to amend The Provincial Secretary's Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Provincial Secretary's Act, being chapter 250 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding immediately after section 8 the following:
- 9. The Lieutenant Governor in Council, for the purposes of administration, may create within the Department one or more branches, bureaus or boards and may prescribe the duties and functions thereof and may delegate to a branch, bureau or board the administration of an Act or the performance of a function assigned to or the responsibility of the Department.
- 10. (1) Publicity for the Province shall, at the direction of the Provincial Secretary, be handled by a bureau within the Department to be known as the Publicity Bureau.
  - (2) The Publicity Bureau shall
  - (a) publicize the resources and development of the Province,
  - (b) have charge of and arrange for the publicity required by any government Department, and
  - (c) be responsible for all government advertising and publications of a publicity or promotional nature.
- 11. The Provincial Secretary may, out of any moneys appropriated for the purpose by the Legislature, make grants to communities in the Province to assist them in acquiring recreational facilities.
- 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
