# BILL

No. 15 of 1961

An Act respecting Annie Sidlowich and the estate of  
James Popiw, deceased

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1961)

WHEREAS Annie Sidlowich has by her petition represented that she was and is the *de facto* adopted daughter of James Popiw, deceased, late of the Village of Waskatenau, in the Province of Alberta; and

WHEREAS the said Annie Sidlowich has by her petition prayed that it be enacted that she be declared to have been and being an adopted *de jure* daughter of the said deceased as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the said petition;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The said Annie Sidlowich is hereby declared to have been and to now be the adopted daughter *de jure* of James Popiw, deceased, as of and after the first day of September, 1920.

2. The said Annie Sidlowich is hereby declared to have been and to now be the lawful heir of the said James Popiw and the successor to the estate and property of the said James Popiw, deceased, together with all the rights and privileges set forth in *The Intestate Succession Act*, as if she were a lawfully adopted daughter of the said deceased pursuant to the laws of the Province of Alberta.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
