A Bill to Terminate the Granting of Further Assistance Under Certain Welfare Statutes

Explanatory Note

General. In 1960 The Public Welfare Act was amended (1960, c. 86) to provide a new form of assistance under the name of "social allowances" which is intended to replace many of the forms of assistance presently in use. Future assistance given by the Department of Public Welfare will be in the form of social allowances and no new pensions or allowances are to be granted under the Acts named in clause 2 of the Bill. Persons presently receiving assistance under those Acts may continue to receive it under them.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Welfare Statutes Amendment Act".
- 2. (1) The Mothers Allowance Act, 1958, being chapter 45 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1958, is amended by striking out sections 6, 7 and 8.
- (2) The Widows' Pensions Act, being chapter 368 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out clause (a) of section 4, and section 7.
- (3) The Supplementary Allowances Act, being chapter 326 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out clauses (a), (b), (f) and (g) of section 5, and section 7.
- (4) The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act, being chapter 86 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out clause (a) of section 4, and section 7.
- 3. (1) On and after the date of commencement of this Act, no applications shall be received for and no person shall be granted a pension or allowance under any of the Acts mentioned in section 2.
- (2) Where before the commencement of this Act a pension or allowance has been granted to a person under any of the Acts mentioned in section 2, the payment of the pension or allowance may be continued in accordance with the Act under which it was granted.
- 4. This Act comes into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.
