HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Cultural Development Act, being chapter 73 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
 - 2. Section 10 is amended,
 - (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1),
 - (b) as to the renumbered subsection (1) by striking out the words "Co-ordinator of Cultural Activities" and by substituting the words "Director of Recreation and Cultural Development",
 - (c) by adding immediately after the renumbered subsection (1) the following:
 - (2) Subject to *The Public Service Act*, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may also appoint such officers, clerks and servants as may be required.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
