An Act to amend The Cultural Development Act

(Assented to _____, 1961)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Cultural Development Act*, being chapter 73 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 10 is amended,

(a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1),

(b) as to the renumbered subsection (1) by striking out the words "Co-ordinator of Cultural Activities" and by substituting the words "Director of Recreation and Cultural Development",

(c) by adding immediately after the renumbered subsection (1) the following:

(2) Subject to *The Public Service Act*, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may also appoint such officers, clerks and servants as may be required.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
