Explanatory Note

- 2. Section 2 (e) presently reads:
 - "2. In this Act,
 - (e) "salary" means the gross rate of an employee's ordinary salary or wages including cost-of-living bonus and holiday pay but does not include moneys paid for travelling expenses, subsistence, overtime work or any other moneys paid in addition to his ordinary salary.".
- 3. Section 7 provides for the crediting of interest on contributions deducted from an employee's salary. Section 7 (2) presently reads:
 - "(2) Such interest shall continue to be so credited to the account of each employee until the date of termination of his service.".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Temporary Provincial Employees Retirement Act, being chapter 54 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 2, clause (e) is amended by striking out the words "gross rate of an employee's ordinary salary or wages" and by substituting the words "actual salary or wages paid to an employee".
- 3. Section 7, subsection (2) is amended by adding immediately after the word "until" the words "the end of the calendar month immediately preceding".
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
