### **Explanatory Note**

General. The Community Chest of Edmonton is being wound up and its place taken by the United Community Fund of Greater Edmonton. This Bill will provide for the substitution of the name of the successor organization in bequests and gifts.

## BILL

An Act to Provide that all Donations to the Community Chest of Edmonton are to be used for the Benefit of the United Community Fund of Greater Edmonton

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The United Community Fund of Greater Edmonton Donation Act".
- 2. In this Act "donation" means any gift, grant, legacy, devise or bequest of real or presonal property of every nature and wheresoever situated.
- 3. Any donation which, by its terms, is to be given, conveyed, transferred, demised or otherwise disposed of to the Community Chest of Edmonton is hereby declared to be altered and amended in so far as may be necessary so that such donation shall be used for the benefit of the United Community Fund of Greater Edmonton as though the name United Community Fund of Greater Edmonton was included in the donation in the place and stead of Community Chest of Edmonton.
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
