#### **Explanatory Note**

2. Section 9 is amended to permit an increased number of board members. Section 9 presently reads:

"9. (1) If, at the expiration of two weeks from the last publication of the newspaper notice, no substantial objection to the formation of the proposed district has been made, the Minister shall appoint a returning officer for the purpose of taking a vote on the formation of the district and for the election of a board.

(2) The Minister is sole judge as to whether an objection is of a substantial nature or not.

(3) The board of each district shall consist of three trustees who shall be persons eligible under section 24 for election.

(4) Matters preparatory to any such election and proceedings thereat and consequent thereon shall be regulated by the provisions of Part II.".

**H**<sup>ER</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Irrigation Districts Act, being chapter 162 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended.

2. Section 9 is amended by striking out subsection (3) and by substituting the following:

(3) The board of each district shall consist of three, five or seven trustees.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
