## **Explanatory Note**

**This Bill will correct a mistake in the Revised Statutes. The words being struck out were contained in The Arbitration Act prior to 1948 but were removed by chapter 45 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948. The repealed words were inadvertently left in The Arbitration Act when the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, were prepared. Section 4, subsection (1) reads:**

**"4. (1) If a party to a submission or a person claiming through or under him commences any legal proceedings in a court against another party to the submission or a person claiming through or under him in respect of a matter agreed to be referred, a party to such legal proceeding may at any time after appearance, and before delivering any pleadings or taking any other steps in the proceedings, apply to that court for an order staying the proceedings."**

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4, subsection (1) of *The Arbitration Act*, being chapter 15 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out the words "after appearance, and".

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
