## **BILL 19**

A Bill to amend Certain Statutes

## Explanatory Note

**2.** The Bills of Sale Act is amended. Section 39 in its present form sets out the amount of fees that may be charged for various services. The amendment will enable the fees to be altered from time to time as circumstances require.

**3.** The Conditional Sales Act is amended. Section 21, subsection (2) and section 22 set out fees that may be charged by the registration clerk for certain services. Section 23, clause (b) reads:

"23. The Lieutenant Governor in Council  
.....

(b) may alter or repeal any of the provisions of section 22 as to fees or prescribe additional or other fees, and".

**4.** The Commissioners for Oaths Act is amended. The provisions being repealed set a \$10.00 fee for an appointment in Calgary or Edmonton or outside the Province; \$5.00 for an appointment in Medicine Hat or Lethbridge; and \$2.00 for an appointment elsewhere in the Province.

# BILL

An Act to amend Certain Statutes

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1962)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Statutory Fees Amendment Act*".

**2.** *The Bills of Sale Act*, being chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out section 39 and by substituting the following:

**39.** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe a tariff of fees to be charged for registering any document, for issuing any certificate and for rendering any other service under this Act.

**3.** *The Conditional Sales Act*, being chapter 54 of the Revised Statutes, is amended

- (a) as to section 21 by striking out subsection (2),
- (b) by striking out section 22, and
- (c) as to section 23 by striking out clause (b) and by substituting the following:
  - (b) may prescribe a tariff of fees to be charged for registering any document, for issuing any certificate and for rendering any other service under this Act, and

**4.** *The Commissioners for Oaths Act*, being chapter 50 of the Revised Statutes, is amended

- (a) as to section 3 by striking out subsection (2),
- (b) as to section 4 by striking out subsection (3), and
- (c) by adding the following new section after section 8:

**9.** (1) The fee payable in respect of each appointment as a commissioner for oaths shall be in such amount as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

(2) In prescribing the fee for appointment as a commissioner for oaths the Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe different fees for different

**5.** The Notaries Public Act is amended. The present section 5 fixes a fee of \$10.00 for an appointment as a Notary Public.

**6.** The Partnership Act is amended. The present section 81 prescribes fixed fees for certain services.

**7.** The Garagemen's Lien Act is amended. The present section 11 sets out a tariff of fees that may be charged for various services.

**8.** The Seizures Act is amended. The present section 47 authorizes the clerk of the court and the sheriff to levy the fees set out in Schedule B and also authorizes the Lieutenant Governor in Council to alter Schedule B. This was done a number of years ago and the Schedule printed in the Revised Statutes is no longer effective.

**9.** Commencement of Act.

**5.** *The Notaries Public Act*, being chapter 222 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out section 5 and by substituting the following:

**5.** The fee payable in respect of each commission issued under this Act shall be in such amount as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

**6.** *The Partnership Act*, being chapter 230 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out section 81 and by substituting the following:

**81.** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe a tariff of fees to be charged for filing any declaration, for issuing any certificate and for rendering any other service under this Act.

**7.** *The Garagemen's Lien Act*, being chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out section 11 and by substituting the following:

**11.** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe a tariff of fees to be charged for registering any document, for issuing any certificate and for rendering any other service under this Act.

**8.** *The Seizures Act*, being chapter 307 of the Revised Statutes, is amended

(a) by striking out section 47 and by substituting the following:

**47.** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe a tariff of fees, costs and charges payable to the clerk of the court and the sheriff in relation to any seizure and which may be chargeable against a debtor.

(b) by striking out Schedule B to the Act.

**9.** This Act comes into force on the first day of June, 1962.
