A Bill to amend The Dairymen's Act

2. Section 28 presently reads in part: "28. The owner, operator, manager or other person in charge of a dairy manufacturing plant shall make and deliver with every payment to each patron from whom milk has been purchased, and in any event at intervals of not more than sixteen days, a statement showing among other details,.....".

3. A new section is added requiring an advance payment to be made to suppliers of milk for the fluid trade in cases where statements are delivered at intervals greater than 16 days.

An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act

(Assented to , 1962)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Dairymen's Act, being chapter 74 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 28 is amended by striking out the word "six-teen" and by substituting the word "thirty-one".

3. The following new section is added immediately after section 28:

28a. (1) This section applies only in respect of milk supplied by a patron for the fluid trade.

(2) Where the owner, operator, manager or other person in charge of a dairy manufacturing plant makes and delivers statements to the patron at intervals of more than sixteen days, he shall make an advance payment to the patron at least fifteen days prior to the date of the next regular payment.

(3) An advance payment required to be made under subsection (2) shall be in an amount equal to one-half of the total payments made to the patron for the period covered by the latest statement made and delivered to the patron.

(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3), if the amount of milk being delivered by the patron is not sufficient to reasonably justify an advance payment in the amount specified in subsection (3), the advance payment may instead, be based on the amount of milk supplied by the patron since the last payment to him.

(5) In addition to the information required by section 28, the statement made and delivered to a patron to whom this section refers shall include

- (a) the butterfat test on a composite sample collected during the first fifteen days of the month,
- (b) the butterfat test on a composite sample collected from the sixteenth day to the last day of the month, and

 Section 48, subsection (1) reads in part: "48. (1) The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may make regulations".

5. Commencement of Act.

(c) the arithmetical mean of the two tests which shall form the basis for monthly payment.

4. Section 48, subsection (1) is amended by adding the following new clause immediately after clause (j):

(j1) prescribing additional information to be contained in the statements delivered to patrons under sections 27, 28 and 28a, or any one of them,

5. This Act comes into force on the first day of June, 1962.
