# BILL 29

A Bill to amend The Local Authorities Board Act

#### **Explanatory Note**

#### 2. Section 11 presently reads:

"11. (1) Subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, the Board may employ the services of such engineers, accountants, legal counsel and technical and professional persons, and such other officers, clerks or employees as the Board deems necessary.

(2) The Board may prescribe the duties and conditions of employment and remuneration of all persons employed by it.".

#### 3. Section 13 presently reads:

"13. Subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, the Board shall appoint a secretary who shall
(a) keep a record of all proceedings conducted before the Board or any member thereof,

- (b) have the custody and care of all records and documents belong-ing to or pertaining to the Board and filed in his office,
- (c) obey all rules or directions given by the Board touching his duties or office, and
- (d) ensure that every regulation, rule or order made by the Board is drawn pursuant to the direction of the Board, properly authen-ticated and retained in his office.".
- 4. Section 120 provides for the separation of lands from an urban municipality. Subsection (6) reads:

"(6) No land shall be separated from any urban municipality otherwise than under the provisions of this section.".

This is in conflict with section 18, subsection (2), clause (b) of The Town and Village Act.

- HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- 1. The Local Authorities Board Act, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1961, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 11 is struck out and the following is substituted:
- 11. Subject to *The Public Service Act*, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint a secretary and such other officers, clerks and servants as are requisite for the conduct of the business of the Board and may prescribe their duties and remuneration.
- 3. Section 13 is amended by striking out all the words preceding clause (a) and by substituting the following:
  - 13. The secretary shall
  - **4.** Section 120 is amended by striking out subsection (6).
- 5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
