A Bill to amend The Lightning Rod Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 15 presently reads:

- “15. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations
- (a) establishing standards and prescribing the kind of materials or apparatus to be used in the protection of buildings and their contents from damage by lightning,
 - (b) respecting the manner and system of installing the material or apparatus, and
 - (c) generally for the enforcement and better carrying out of the provisions of this Act.”.

3. Authority is given to adopt codes.

4. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Lightning Rod Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Lightning Rod Act*, being chapter 176 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 15 is amended by adding immediately after clause (a) the following new clause:

(a1) prescribing the forms to be used in any matter under this Act,

3. The following new section is added immediately after section 15:

15a. (1) If a code of lightning rod installation rules has been promulgated by any association or body of persons and is available in printed form, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister, declare such code to be in force either in whole or in part or with such variations as may be specified in the order.

(2) Upon publication in the *Gazette* of any such order, the rules thereby declared to be in force, subject to such variations as may be specified in the order, take effect from the date on which the order is published or from such later date as may be designated for that purpose and have the same effect as if they were rules and regulations made under this Act.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
