A Bill to amend The Brand Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 10, subsection (3) reads:

“(3) No brand shall be allotted to an Indian in an Indian Reserve unless the allotting of a brand is approved by the Regional Supervisor of the Indian Agency for the Province of Alberta.”.

3. The relevant part of the Tariff of Fees reads:

.....

“On application for allotment of a brand \$2.00
On application for reallocation of a brand \$2.00”.

An Act to amend The Brand Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Brand Act*, being chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 10 is amended by striking out subsection (3).

3. The Tariff of Fees in the Schedule as to the Fees Payable in Respect of all other Brands is amended with respect to the fee on application for allotment of a brand and the fee on application of reallocation of a brand by striking out the figures "2.00" and by substituting the figures "5.00" in both cases.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
