2. Section 15, subsection (1) presently reads:

"15. (1) The city, town, village, municipal district, county, improve-ment district or special area in which a mentally defective person is resident at the time of his admission to an institution under this Act shall pay to the Minister on demand

- (a) the costs of the justice of the peace,
- (b) the costs incurred in bringing the mentally defective person before the justice of the peace,
- (c) the costs of transportation,
- (c) the costs of transportation,
 (d) all other costs incurred up to the time of admission of the mentally defective person to the institution,
 (e) where the mentally defective person is under twenty-one years, the sum of fifty cents a day for each day the person is in the institution.".

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Mental Defectives Act, being chapter 199 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 15, subsection (1) is amended by striking out clause (e) and by substituting the following:

(e) where the mentally defective person is under twenty-one years, such sum for each day the person is in the institution as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

3. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, 1962.
