## Explanatory Note

### 2. Section 15, subsection (1) presently reads:

"15. (1) The city, town, village, municipal district, county, improvement district or special area in which a mentally defective person is resident at the time of his admission to an institution under this Act shall pay to the Minister on demand

- (a) the costs of the justice of the peace,
- (b) the costs incurred in bringing the mentally defective person before the justice of the peace,
- (c) the costs of transportation,
- (d) all other costs incurred up to the time of admission of the mentally defective person to the institution,
- (e) where the mentally defective person is under twenty-one years, the sum of fifty cents a day for each day the person is in the institution."

### 3. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Mental Defectives Act

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Mental Defectives Act*, being chapter 199 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 15, subsection (1) is amended by striking out clause (e) and by substituting the following:
  - (e) where the mentally defective person is under twenty-one years, such sum for each day the person is in the institution as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the first day of April, 1962.
