Explanatory Note

2. Section 3, subsection (1) presently reads:

"3. (1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may, by order in council, establish a Provincial General Hospital in Calgary."

3. Section 13 presently reads:

"13. (1) The board, with the approval of the Minister, shall appoint a medical administrator of the hospital and such other administrative personnel as may be required for the efficient operation of the hospital.

(2) The board shall assign the duties of the medical administrator."

4. A Provincial General Hospital may transfer property to a Hospital Foundation.

5. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Provincial General Hospitals Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Provincial General Hospitals Act*, being chapter 64 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1959, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3, subsection (1) is amended by adding immediately at the end thereof the words "and a Provincial General Hospital in Edmonton".

3. Section 13 is amended

- (a) as to subsection (1) by striking out the words "a medical administrator" and by substituting the words "an executive director or administrator",
- (b) as to subsection (2) by striking out the words "medical administrator" and by substituting the words "executive director or administrator".

4. Section 18 is struck out and the following is substituted:

18. (1) In this section "foundation" means a corporation established to receive, hold, administer and apply any property or the income therefrom for purposes or objects in connection with a Provincial General Hospital.

(2) Where any real or personal property is held by a board for any purpose or object similar to those of a foundation, the board,

- (a) with the approval of the Minister, and
- (b) upon such terms, not inconsistent with any trust or condition under which the property is held, as it deems expedient,

may transfer or assign the property to the foundation.

(3) Subsection (2) applies to property acquired or accumulated before or after the commencement of this section and whether acquired by gift, bequest, devise or otherwise.

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
