BILL 76

A Bill to amend The Psychologists Association Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 7, subsections (1), (2) and (5) presently read:

"7. (1) The affairs of the association shall be managed by a council which shall consist of five members of the association.

(2) At the first meeting of the association and at every subsequent annual meeting thereafter the members of the association shall elect the members of the council.

(5) Three members of the council constitute a quorum."

3. Section 8, subsection (1) presently reads:

"8. (1) The council shall elect annually from its members a president, a secretary-treasurer and such other officers as it deems necessary."

4. Section 10 which authorizes the making of by-laws on different subjects is amended.

5. A new section is added to prevent unqualified persons from practising psychology.

An Act to amend The Psychologists Association Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Psychologists Association Act*, being chapter 79 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1960, is hereby amended.

2. Section 7 is amended

(a) by striking out subsections (1) and (2) and by substituting the following:

7. (1) The affairs of the association shall be managed by a council of eight members of the association, consisting of the president, the past president, two vice-presidents, the secretary-treasurer and the chairmen of the standing committees on membership and ethics, on publications and publicity and on professional standards and training.

(2) At every annual meeting the members of the association shall elect the members of the council and the chairmen of the standing committees.

(b) as to subsection (5) by striking out the word "Three" and by substituting the word "Four".

3. Section 8 is amended by striking out subsection (1).

4. Section 10, subsection (1) is amended

(a) by striking out the word "and" at the end of clause (g) and by adding the word "and" at the end of clause (h),

(b) by adding immediately after clause (h) the following new clause:

(i) providing for the holding of conferences and meetings of an informative or cultural nature and for the publication of magazines, periodicals and single papers.

5. The following new section is added immediately after section 19:

19a. (1) A person

- (a) who is unable to produce a certificate from the General Faculty Council in accordance with subsection (1) of section 12, or
- (b) who is not a full member of the association, or
- (c) who is not permitted under any other law of the Province to practice psychology,

and who practices psychology is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in section 22.

(2) A person practices psychology

- (a) who holds himself out to the public by any title or description of services containing the words "psychology", "psychologist" or "psychological", and
- (b) who, under any such title or description, offers to render or renders services of the nature ordinarily rendered by psychologists to any person, for hire, gain or hope of reward.

6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
