A Bill to amend The Gas Protection Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 2, clause (c) presently reads:

“(c) “gas installation”

- (i) means the installation of gas piping and equipment in or upon any land or premises, or mobile or fixed buildings or any vehicles, for the utilization of gas as a fuel for heating, power or lighting, otherwise than in an industrial or manufacturing process, and
- (ii) includes the connection of any such gas piping with any gas consuming equipment and any part of the gas system, and the maintenance, alteration, extension and repair of any gas piping, but
- (iii) does not include any electrical installation within the meaning of The Electrical Protection Act;”.

3. Section 3 presently reads:

“3. Subject to section 4, this Act applies to gas installations and gas equipment for consumers and to the inspection of such gas installations and gas equipment and to the manufacture, sale and installation of gas equipment.”.

4. Section 4 presently reads:

“4. This Act does not apply to

- (a) collection, transmission and distribution systems of public utilities within the meaning of The Public Utilities Act, or
- (b) any gas equipment or gas installation which may be exempted by the Lieutenant Governor in Council from the operation of this Act.”.

5. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Gas Protection Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Gas Protection Act*, being chapter 129 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2, clause (c) is amended by striking out sub-clause (i) and by substituting the following:

(i) means that portion of a distribution system within the corporate boundaries of a city, town or village and gas piping and equipment in or upon any land or premises of the ultimate consumer, or mobile or fixed buildings or any vehicles, for utilization of gas as a fuel for heating, power or lighting, otherwise than in an industrial or manufacturing process, and

3. Section 3 is amended by striking out the words "for consumers".

4. Section 4 is amended by striking out clause (a).

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
