A Bill to amend The Welding Act

HON. MR. REIERSON

Explanatory Note

2. Section 8 reads:

"8. No person shall engage in the trade of welding who is not the holder of a valid certificate of proficiency under this Act."

3. Section 9 presently reads:

"9. No employer or other person shall authorize or order any employee or any subordinate who is not the holder of a valid certificate of proficiency to engage in or undertake any welding operation."

An Act to amend The Welding Act

(Assented to _____, 1962)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Welding Act*, being chapter 366 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 8 is amended by renumbering the section as subsection (1) and by adding immediately after the renumbered subsection (1) the following:

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person who is not the holder of a valid certificate of proficiency under this Act may be authorized by the Provincial Apprenticeship Board under section 14 of *The Apprenticeship Act* to be employed in the trade of welding, subject to such restrictions as may be made a part of such authorization.

3. Section 9 is amended by adding immediately after the word "proficiency" the words "or authority under section 14 of *The Apprenticeship Act*".

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
