# **BILL 110**

A Bill to amend The Alberta Livestock and Livestock Products Act

### **Explanatory Note**

- 2. Section 2, clause (e) presently reads:
  - "(e) "patron" means a farmer, rancher or other person,

    - (i) who maintains livestock on his own premises for the purpose of propagation or the production of livestock products, or
      (ii) who maintains feeder livestock on his own premises for a period of not less than thirty days for the purpose of fattening, and who brings or supplies the livestock or livestock products to a person engaged in the business of dealing in livestock or livestock products;".
- 3. Section 5, subsection (1), clause (a) and subsection (7) presently read:

  - "5. (1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may by regulation
    (a) require all persons engaged in the business of dealing in livestock or livestock products or both, or in a specified kind or
    kinds thereof, whether as a principal or an agent, including
    the operator of any stock yard, to be licensed,".
  - "(7) Nothing in this section applies to a person who is a patron and who buys or sells livestock in the ordinary course of his business.".

An Act to amend The Alberta Livestock and Livestock Products Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Livestock and Livestock Products Act, beting chapter 181 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (e) and by substituting the following:
  - (e) "patron" means a farmer, rancher or other person,
    - (i) who maintains livestock for the purpose of propagation or the production of livestock products, or
    - (ii) who maintains feeder livestock for a period of not less than thirty days for the purpose of fattening,

and includes a licensed livestock dealer;

- 3. Section 5 is amended
- (a) as to subsection (1) by adding immediately after clause (a) the following:
  - (a1) exempt any class of persons dealing in livestock or livestock products, or both, from the requirement of licensing upon such condtions, if any, as he may prescribe,
- (b) by striking out subsection (7) and by substituting the following:
  - (7) Nothing in this section applies to a person who is a farmer, rancher or feeder in the Province and who buys and sells livestock in the ordinary course of his farming, ranching or feeding operations.
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
