## Explanatory Note

### 1. Section 2 presently reads:

"2. For the purpose of obtaining for Alberta the benefits of any arrangements or proposals of the Government of Canada relating to any or all of the following matters, that is to say:

- (a) farm or other land use and conservation, including irrigation and water development;
- (b) farm credit;
- (c) crop insurance;

the Minister of Agriculture is hereby empowered to enter into agreements with the appropriate Ministers of the Government of Canada to that purpose and may obligate the Province to any extent considered necessary to obtain any such benefit or to effect any such arrangements or proposals in Alberta."

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Federal-Provincial Farm Assistance Act*, being chapter 17 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1959, is amended as to section 2 by adding the following new clause after clause (c):

(d) rural development projects;

**2.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
