Preamble

WHEREAS Berean Bible College, Calgary, Alberta, has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to Berean Bible College from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The property located at Calgary, Alberta, described as follows, namely:

- (1) That portion of Lot A in Block 62 which lies to the west of the southerly production of the western boundary of Lot 55 in said Block 62 as shown in a plan Tuxedo Park Calgary 2617 A.G.
- (2) Lots 15 to 54 inclusive in Block 62 according to a plan of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 2617 A.G.

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as it shall remain registered in the name of Berean Bible College and owned by it and used by it for or in connection with educational purposes.

Commence-

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
