An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Land Which is the Property of The Society for Christian Education in Southern Alberta, Lethbridge, Alberta, from Assessment and Taxation.

Preamble

WHEREAS The Society for Christian Education in Southern Alberta, Lethbridge, Alberta has presented a petition, praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to The Society for Christian Education in Southern Alberta from assessment and taxation, other than that relating to local improvements, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. The property located at Lethbridge, Alberta, described as follows, namely: Lot Four (4), Block C, according to a Plan of part of the City of Lethbridge of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Lethbridge 583 J.K., containing 5.475 acres more or less, excepting thereout all mines and minerals and the right to work the same, shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements, so long as it shall remain registered in the name of The Society for Christian Education in Southern Alberta, and owned by it and used by it, for or connection with educational purposes.

Commencement of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
