A Bill to amend The Cancer Treatment and Prevention Act

Explanatory Note

1. The Cancer Treatment and Prevention Act, which provides for the taking of various measures for the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of cancer is amended to provide for the establishment of advisory boards.

An Act to amend The Cancer Treatment and Prevention Act

(Assented to _____, 1963)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Cancer Treatment and Prevention Act*, being chapter 35 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding the following new section immediately after section 6:

7. The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council,

- (a) may appoint a lay advisory board to advise the Director of Cancer Services on matters relating to the relationship of the cancer clinics to the general public and to financial and administrative problems of the clinics, and
- (b) may appoint a medical advisory board to advise the Director of Cancer Services on problems relating to the medical profession.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
