Explanatory Note

- 2. Clause (h) of section 15, is revised to allow the Minister to prescribe and to handle matters pertaining to the security given by keepers and operators of trade schools. Clause (h) of section 15 presently reads:
 - "15.The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations
 - (h) prescribing the security to be provided by the keeper or operator of any trade school for the due performance of his contracts,".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Trade Schools Regulation Act, being chapter 339 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 15 is amended by striking out clause (h) and by substituting the following:
 - (h) requiring security to be provided by the keeper or operator of any trade school for the due performance of his contracts with students, in such form and in such amount as the Minister, subject to the regulations, may determine,
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
