An Act to amend The Fuel Oil Licensing Act

(Assented to _____, 1963)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Fuel Oil Licensing Act*, being chapter 124 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.

2. Section 25 is amended by renumbering the section as subsection (1) and by adding immediately after the renumbered subsection (1) the following:

(2) A person who gives to other persons, or who permits, suffers or allows other persons to take fuel oil owned by him, either with or without consent, is deemed to be a jobber, wholesaler, or retailer within the meaning of this section.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
