- 2. The number of judges in addition to the Chief Justice in the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of Alberta, is increased from 4 to 5.
- 3. The hours that clerks of the court are required to keep their offices open are changed from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

#### An Act to amend The Judicature Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Judicature Act, being chapter 164 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 6, subsection (2), clause (b) is amended by striking out the word "four" and by substituting the word "five".
- 3. Section 43, subsection (1) is amended by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:
  - (a) attend at his office to keep the office open between the hours of nine-thirty in the forenoon and four in the afternoon on all days except Saturdays and holidays when the office shall be closed, and
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
