An Act to Establish the Northern Alberta Development Council

(Assented to , 1963)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Northern Alberta Development Council Act".
- 2. In this Act "Council" means the Northern Alberta Development Council.
- 3. There is hereby established a council to be known as the Northern Alberta Development Council.
- 4. The functions of the Council are to investigate, plan, promote, co-ordinate and advise the Government on practical measures to foster and advance development in northern Alberta, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing may investigate and recommend on the requirements of the area in the matter of
 - (a) industrial development,
 - (b) transportation facilities,
 - (c) agricultural stabilization,
 - (d) metis rehabilitation,
 - (e) educational facilities, and
 - (f) local administration.
- 5. The Council shall be composed of not more than five members to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council and may include elected members of the Legislative Assembly.
- **6.** Subject to *The Public Service Act, 1962*, there may be appointed a Director and such employees as are necessary to assist the Council to fulfil its functions.
- 7. For the purpose of carrying out its functions the Council may hold public meetings and employ expert consultants as it thinks necessary.

- 8. Provision for payment of salaries and expenses, the payment of which is not deemed to contravene The Legislative Assembly Act.
 - 9. Annual report.
 - 10. Commencement of Act.

- 8. (1) A member of the Council may be paid a salary and compensation for travelling and other expenses incurred as a member as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe.
- (2) Payment of a salary and expenses under this section to a member of the Council who is a member of the Legislative Assembly is not deemed to contravene the provisions of *The Legislative Assembly Act* respecting eligibility.
- 9. The Council shall prepare an annual report of its activities which shall be laid before the Legislative Assembly not later than fifteen days after the opening of the session next following the preparation of the report.
- 10. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
