#### An Act to amend The Libraries Act

#### (Assented to , 1963)

**H**<sup>ER</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Libraries Act, being chapter 27 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 20 is struck out and the following section is substituted:

**20.** (1) In municipalities where the population is fifteen thousand or more, no more than two members of the council, in addition to the mayor, shall be members of the board at the same time.

(2) In municipalities where the population is less than fifteen thousand, no more than one member of the council, in addition to the mayor, shall be a member of the board.

**3.** The following new section is added after section 21:

**21***a*. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Act, a council may at any time and for any reason it considers proper revoke the appointment of a member of a board and appoint a successor to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
