Preamble

WHEREAS Alberta Bible College, Calgary, Alberta, has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to Alberta Bible College from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The property located at Calgary, Alberta, described as follows, namely:

(1) That portion of Lot Thirty-four (34) in Block Eight (8) which lies to the North East of the South West Two Hundred (200) feet through of the said Lot Thirty-four (34) as shown in a Plan Calgary 9043 H.A. shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as it shall remain in the name of Alberta Bible College and owned by it and used by it for or in connection with educational purposes.

Commence-

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
