Preamble

WHEREAS The Royal Trust Company as Trustee of the Will of the late Peter Willoughby King has presented a petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands with improvements thereon from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. The lands located within the City of Calgary in the Province of Alberta and described as follows, namely:

Lots Three (3) to Eleven (11) inclusive in Block Thirty-six (36) according to a plan of part of the said City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 2187-V with the improvements thereon so long as they are owned by the Petitioner or other trustee or trustees of the said Will for the maintenance, support and care of poor women and children resident in the said City of Calgary, shall be exempt from assessment and taxation, except local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals.

Commencement of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
