Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for an amendment to An Act to Incorporate the Sisters of Charity (Grey Nuns) of Alberta, being chapter 114 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, for the purpose of exempting from taxation certain property located in the Village of Legal, Alberta; and

WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the said petition.

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Tax
exemption

1. Chapter 114 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, being *An Act to Incorporate the Sisters of Charity (Grey Nuns) of Alberta* is amended by adding after section 13 the following new section:

13a. The following land, namely:

Lots One (1) to Fifteen (15) inclusive in Block Five (5) in the Townsite of Legal, in the Province of Alberta, Dominion of Canada, as shown on Subdivision Plan 7710 U.

Reserving unto Her Majesty all mines and minerals, together with the buildings located thereon shall be exempt from assessment and taxation so long as the same are used for educational purposes except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals.

Commence-
ment of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
