A Bill to amend The Municipal and Provincial
Properties Valuation Act

HON. MR. HOOKE

Explanatory Note

1. The Municipal and Provincial Properties Valuation Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1961, chapter 53, amended.

2. Section 8, subsection (1) presently reads:

"8. (1) Notwithstanding clause (k) of subsection (1) of section 544 of The City Act or clause (b) of section 14 of The Assessment Act, 1960, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may provide that the valuation of any type, class or classes of municipally owned property valued in accordance with this Act shall become the assessment of that property and that the property is liable to assessment and taxation by the municipality in which the property is situated."

Section 544, subsection (1), clause (o) of The City Act pertains to the exemption of city property from taxation and the amendment here will remove the existing conflict between the Acts.

3. Commencement of Act.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Municipal and Provincial Properties Valuation Act* is hereby amended.

2. Section 8, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the words "clause (*k*)" and by substituting the words "clauses (*k*) and (*o*)".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1964.
