An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Lands
belonging to the Boy Scouts of Canada, Calgary

Preamble

WHEREAS the Boy Scouts of Canada, Calgary Regional Council has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to the Boy Scouts of Canada, Calgary Regional Council from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and that relating to minerals and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The following properties, namely:

- (a) Lots 25 and 26 in Block 17 according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 2129 O.
- (b) Lots 5 and 6 in Block 2 according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 6704 G.J.,
Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
- (c) Lots 34 and 35 in Block 3 according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 4992 A.C.,
Reserving unto the Canadian Pacific Railway Company all coal and petroleum and unto William A. Hicks all other minerals.
- (d) Lots 5, 6 and 7 in Block 1 according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Ogden Calgary 955 A.V.,
Reserving out of Lot 5 unto the Canadian Pacific Railway Company all mines and minerals, and reserving out of Lots 6 and 7 unto the said Canadian Pacific Railway Company all mines and minerals as set forth in Transfer registered as 8851 E.I.

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as they shall remain registered in the name of the Boy Scouts of Canada, Calgary Regional Council and be owned by it and used by it for or in connection with the purposes of the said organization in the development of good citizenship among boys.

Commence-
ment of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the thirty-first day of December, 1963.
